Qualification for Volunteer NSG Committee Member(s)

- Is a resident of Delta
- Adequate availability, flexibility and capacity, especially during the busiest months of the project. (March, April and November). Ability to follow the project to completion (ie one year commitment).
- Strong teamwork, cooperation and collaboration skills
- The ability to share space and get along well with others, including those with different life experiences and personal styles and a commitment to valuing everyone's contributions.
- Strong communication skills (including active listening)
- Good conflict resolution skills
- Self-awareness around confidentiality, conflict of interest, and bias
- The ability and willingness to communicate regularly with the Coordinator and with other Committee members when necessary – preferably by both phone and email.
- The ability to understand applicant's ideas and intentions, and seek more information when necessary. Involvement in community projects/development an asset.
- The ability to understand and synthesize the guidelines and apply them to the applications and decision making process. A balance of both big picture and detail thinking is an asset
- "That members demonstrate tolerance, openness, a sense of humor, and a willingness to be part of the team." (Steering Committee Minutes, Dec 1 1999)
- Alignment with the values of the project, including
 - The belief that each individual has something positive to contribute their community
 - Supporting, valuing and reflecting the diversity of our communities
 - Community building – bringing people together and building new relationships
 - Building leadership and capacity amongst residents – getting more people involved, engaged and participating in the community
 - Putting trust in the ability of local residents to use the grant money well
